Standard Technology, Inc. Opens a Remote Coding Center in Hampton Roads

Virginia's Hampton Roads - The Hampton Roads Economic Development Alliance announced today that Standard Technology Inc. (STI), based in Falls Church, Virginia, has opened a Remote Coding Center in Hampton, Virginia. STI is a technology and management consulting firm delivering health and information technology services to government and commercial clients in four major areas: Health Information Management, Financial and Resource Management, Program Management, and Conference and Event Management.

STI is a market leader in remote coding solutions with a reputation for improving the quality and timeliness of coding through remote support. STIGlobalCode, a proprietary DITSCAP-certified, HIPAA-compliant tool, transmits patient information needed for securing insurance reimbursement to the STI Remote Coding Center in Hampton for coding and subsequent data entry. STI's robust web infrastructure supports the coding of over 80,000 patient visits monthly with a 95-100% accuracy rate and <48 hours timeliness.

STI manages the US Navy's coding and auditing functions for military medical facilities in the East Coast region (Virginia, Maryland, Rhode Island, Connecticut, Maine and New Hampshire), and also implements Remote Coding to world wide Navy MTFs (Yokosuka, JA; Okinawa, JA; Sigonella, IT; Naples, IT; Rota, SP and Guantanamo Bay, Cuba). STI provides similar services to two major Navy regions as well as the following Army and Air Force commands: US Army Medical Department Activity Heidelberg; the 121st Hospital in Korea; MacDill AFB and Andrews AFB.

"We are very pleased to be opening a remote coding center in beautiful Hampton Roads," said STI Executive Vice President Kenyatta Jenkins. "Over the past 12 months, STI has experienced tremendous growth in our Health Information Management Services (HIMS) operation. Remote coding has grown from supporting one Army hospital in Germany to supporting nine overseas medical facilities worldwide."
